The mission of the Liberty Ball is to provide emotional and financial support to the children, families, researchers, and staff of Four Diamonds. Since the first Liberty Ball in 2006, the event has raised more than \$350,000 to help fight pediatric cancer.

Four Diamonds

Four Diamonds provides direct support to approximately 600 children with cancer each year - 100 who are newly diagnosed and 500 who are continuing their fight. Four Diamonds offsets the cost of treatment that is not covered by insurance and any expenses that may disrupt the welfare of the child. Four Diamonds also supports a diverse platform of pediatric research at Penn State Hershey Children's Hospital. Since its founding in 1972, Four Diamonds has helped over 4,000 children and families, many of whom reside in the Greater Philadelphia area.
